Good Foot provides training and employment to over 30 neurodivergent individuals who make up our Courier team. The organization works with every Courier on an ongoing basis to strengthen their skills and experience, helping to maximize their potential and overall independence.

Good Foot's employment and training program: <u>Good Foot Forward</u> offers a hybrid learning opportunity for individuals interested in gaining transferable employability skills and work experience. Small groups of participants learn and engage in an inclusive, supportive environment over the course of the 9 month program.

Good Foot is so much more than a job - we are a community that enables every Courier and program participant to feel connected, empowered and independent through ongoing learning opportunities, social programs and wrap-around support.

About the Role

Good Foot is seeking an independent, driven student in the field of Social Work, Social Service Work, Community Work or related field to assist with building, hosting, and growing our social programming this summer. The placement student will assist in the planning, preparation, and facilitation of community social events, closely following the programs calendar for 2025.

The student will gain valuable skills in nonprofit program facilitation and development, project management, budgeting, reporting and research, accessibility, and engaging neurodivergent adults.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop and facilitate a biweekly drop-in social program
- Following our 2025 programs calendar, plan, prepare for, and facilitate social programming
- Conduct outreach with Couriers and program participants on a variety of platforms to increase engagement and participation in scheduled programming
- Liaise with internal and external stakeholders to coordinate logistics for programs
- Liaise with Couriers and program participants to discuss preferences for social programs, and where possible, plan to incorporate suggestions into future programming
